#### **Session Breakdown/What your Child Gets**

Includes the following structured activities:

Daily focus on essential social pragmatic skill development

Meal/snack prep

Games/activities, which address:

Language processing

Sensory integration  
Social Pragmatics  
Cooperative learning  
Physical development  
Fine/gross motor skills  
Functional activities

Hands-on - creative crafts  
Drama/play  
Self-awareness  
Visual materials to take home  
With an overall focus on self-esteem building and FUN

Same basic daily routine/structure w/change in activity and learning experience ideally,  
daily outing\* (pond, beach, town, etc.) depends on group and location  
\*Scheduled outings w/guided supports are options w/possible parental/caregiver support

Daily notes, as well as individual **Progress Note** written at the end of the session, will be provided to identify the child's current social-pragmatic skill level. Progress note will be mailed to families.
